



LAW ENFORCEMENT INVESTIGATOR ELECTION LAW UNIT OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

The New Hampshire Department of Justice seeks a full-time law enforcement investigator for its Election Law Unit to investigate alleged violations of New Hampshire's election and campaign finance laws and to assist with administrative enforcement or criminal prosecutions when appropriate. In addition to its enforcement role, the Unit helps ensure election integrity by partnering with the Secretary of State to train elections officials on laws pertaining to voter eligibility, registration processes, polling place protocols and vote tabulation procedures. On election days, the Unit also staffs a phone hotline fielding inquiries from election officials and may help inspect polling places. Fully staffed, the Unit includes two attorneys, two investigators, and a paralegal, working within a collaborative and collegial environment.

The successful candidate must be certified as a law enforcement officer in New Hampshire (or eligible to obtain certification) and have experience testifying in court and proficiency with current investigative techniques, witness interviews, search warrants (applications for and execution of), subpoenas, evidence collection, and report writing.
